- What is the significance of wisdom being portrayed in this passage both within the home (v8-19) and out in the public square (v20-33)? Which context is more of a challenge for you?
- What is the attraction of joining the "gang" in v10-11? How does what is promised compare to what actually happens?
- Where do we face the same kind of pressure and temptation in our lives as that portrayed in v8-19?
- What kind of calamity is Lady Wisdom warning of in v26-27? In what ways could apparent success in our lives turn out to be calamity?
- Is it loving or unloving to warn of calamity in this way? Why? Do we find that hard or easy when we share the gospel with others?
- Do you struggle to believe that true freedom is found in walking the path of wisdom by following Jesus? Why/why not?
- In what ways do these verses point us to Jesus? Can you think of similar things that Jesus said?
