For further discussion

- What distracts in you in your life?
- How does the listening in v1-4 compare with the way we often read the Bible? How much does distraction affect that?
- In what sense is it true that God always protects those who trust him (v6-8)? What would you say to someone who is experiencing suffering or hardship as a Christian?
- Why does wisdom need to enter our hearts (v9-11)? Why is this promise such good news?
- It is the words of the wicked men and the adulteress that initially attract the foolish (v12, 16). What kind of things might be said by their kind today? What kind of promises would they make?
- What is the link between the covenant breaking of the adulteress in v17 and the cutting off from the land in v22? How does this help us understand why the Bible's view of sex and relationships is not arbitrary but points to the heart of the gospel?
- According to this chapter, what is the best remedy for temptation? How can that help us when we are tempted?
