

## Jude vs 3-16: Remember God's Justice

### **Jesus the Judge - judges with perfect justice**

**1) He showed his previous judgements against the ungodly**

(v5-7)

**2) He reserves the ungodly for eternal destruction**

(v8-13)

**3) He will come to execute his final judgement**

(v14-16)

### **For further discussion**

- Why would Jude write such a lengthy passage on Judgement in his very short letter? How would it help Christians to 'contend for the faith' in v3?
