(v1-3)

### **One thing – the prayer that is always answered:**

#### **1) To dwell...**

(v4-6)

#### **2) To gaze...**

(v7-10)

#### **3) To seek...**

(v11-14)

### **For further discussion**

- How easy do you find it to wait? How do you respond when you feel God is taking too long to keep his promises?
- What is the one thing David prays for? How confident can we be that God will answer this prayer if we pray it?
- David longed to dwell in God's temple (v4-6). What does that look like now that Jesus has come? How can we dwell with Jesus daily?
- David's desire was to gaze on God's face (v7-10). What is the difference between knowing about God and actually knowing God? What does knowing God look like today?
- Knowing God means seeking his ways (v11-14). Why does obedience bring confidence?
- How would Jesus have prayed this psalm? What difference does it make to pray it in him? How does this psalm give confidence as we wait?
- Pray the psalm for yourself and others.
