Talk 1: Daniel is Deliberately Distinctive

Bible Passage: Daniel - Chapters 1 & 2

Points:

A) Be distressed at the world's depravity

B) Delight in God's Sovereignty

C) Determine to be distinctive

D) Display God's grace

Discussion questions:

1. In what situations has/might knowing that God is in total control help(ed) you to live for Him in this messed up world?

2. How engaged and involved are you in the non-Christian world? How could you get more involved? What temptations to compromise might you face and how could you avoid them?

3. Day to day what opportunities do you have to display God's grace to those who don't yet know him? How could you use those opportunities more effectively?

Talk 2: God is Supremely Sovereign

Bible Passage: Daniel - Chapter 5

Points:

A) God warns the arrogant

B) God controls events

C) God speaks through his servants

D) God acts in judgement

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Isaiah 40:6-31. Quickly jot down what we learn about people v6, 15, 17, 22, 23-4, 30. Compare to what we learn about God v22, 25, 26, 28, 29...How might this help us avoid Belshazzar's arrogance?! What practical steps could you take to stay humble day by day?

2. What opportunities do you have in a normal week to speak about God/Jesus to those who do not know him? How could you make the most of those opportunities? I guess we all find it hard...how can what we learn of God here encourage us to be more courageous?

3. How comfortable are you with the thought of God's judgement? Why do you think you feel this way? How can a better understanding of it encourage us when times are hard and prompt us to pray for others and witness to them?

Talk 3: Daniel is Fearlessly Faithful

Bible Passage: Daniel - Chapter 6

Points:

A) Expect conflict

B) Establish character

C) Envisage the ending

D) Endure beyond death

Discussion Questions:

1. When have you experienced conflict for being a Christian? How would expecting conflict help you to stand firm in those situations?

2. Honestly - how regularly do you pray, read the Bible and meet with other Christians for support and encouragement? How could you establish better habits? How could you help each other?

3. We have a wonderful and certain future hope – we know how it ends – and it is fantastic! Spend some time reading Revelation 21. Remind yourself how it ends. How will this help you live a consistent Christian life, whatever the pressure?
